

reFRESH Estero Blvd/Waterlines
Construction Look Ahead – Week of April 2, 2018
(Changes shown in red.)

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Lovers Lane to Albatross Street. **Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays.** Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.



Estero Boulevard Improvements

This week, reFRESH Estero Boulevard crews are scheduled to perform the following activities on Estero Boulevard. The active work zone is from Lovers Lane to Flamingo Street. Motorists should expect travel lanes on Estero Boulevard to be shifted from Lovers Lane south to Flamingo Street. Two travel lanes will remain open the majority of the time; however, intermittent lane closures may be necessary. Motorists should use caution.

Segment 1 – Crescent Street to Lovers Lane

Intermittent lane closures may be necessary while crews work on punch list items.

Segment 2 – Lovers Lane to Strandview Avenue/Publix

Lovers Lane to Strandview Avenue/Publix – Northbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews work on the bay side.

South of Donora Boulevard to Jefferson Street – Crews will form and pour curb and sidewalk bay side. **Please be aware of where the construction work is occurring. Residents adjacent to Estero Boulevard may need to obtain a temporary parking pass while concrete curb sidewalk and driveway aprons are being installed. - Crews will place base rock and construct intersections at the following driveways and side streets:

7-11 store driveway
Madison Court

Eucalyptus Court
Washington Avenue

Voorhis Street

Access from Estero Boulevard to the above side streets will be closed. Motorists should use Shell Mound Boulevard to detour to Donora Boulevard or Jefferson Street to access Estero Boulevard. This work and the suggested detours are expected to take approximately 2 weeks.

Mid Island Drive to Strandview Avenue/Publix – Crews will install drainage structures and pipe at each side street working from north to south over the next couple months. **This work will be completed on one side of the road at a time. Flaggers will assist motorists. The following streets are scheduled to have drainage structures installed this week:**

- Andre Mar Drive
- Anchorage Street
- St. Peters Drive

Segment 3 and 4 – Strandview Avenue/Publix to Albatross Street

reFRESH Estero Boulevard crews are installing the new sanitary sewer force main on the bay side of Estero Boulevard.

Strandview Avenue/Publix to Flamingo Street – Northbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews work on the bay side.

Sterling Avenue to Flamingo Street - Crews are installing sanitary sewer force main on the bay side. The location of work will shift daily. Please be aware of where the construction work is occurring. Residents adjacent to Estero Boulevard may experience ingress/egress delays when the pipe is being installed at your driveway. Crews can temporarily provide access, if necessary.

Segment 5 and 6 – Albatross Street to end of island

No work at this time.

Phase 2 – Lovers Lane to Madera Road

reFRESH Waterlines crews have installed the new water main on the beach side of Estero Boulevard and **completed the individual and street connections.** Crews are grouting the old water main.

Phase 2 – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing new water main and storm drainage on the following side streets:

Donora Boulevard – Crews are making individual water connections.

Eucalyptus Court – Crews are restoring the right-of-way.

Jefferson Street – Crews are restoring the right-of-way.

Connecticut Street – Crews are installing storm drain pipe.

Bay Mar Drive – Crews have installed water main.

Hercules Drive – Crews are installing storm drain pipe.

Bayview Avenue - Crews are scheduled to work on the bay seawall.

Bay Road (including Nature View Court) – Crews are expected to start water main installation on Bay Road and Nature View Court in April. Storm drain installation on Bay Road only is expected to start at the end of the school year.
