

reFRESH Estero Blvd/Waterlines
Construction Look Ahead – Week of March 19, 2018
(Changes shown in red.)

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Lovers Lane to Albatross Street. **Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays.** Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.



Estero Boulevard Improvements

This week, reFRESH Estero Boulevard crews are scheduled to perform the following activities on Estero Boulevard. The active work zone is from Lovers Lane to Flamingo Street. Motorists should expect travel lanes on Estero Boulevard to be shifted from Lovers Lane south to Aberdeen Avenue. Two travel lanes will remain open the majority of the time; however, intermittent lane closures may be necessary. Motorists should use caution.

Segment 1 – Crescent Street to Lovers Lane

Two travel lanes will remain open the majority of the time; however, intermittent lane closures may be necessary while crews work on punch list items.

Segment 2 – Lovers Lane to Strandview Avenue/Publix

Lovers Lane to Strandview Avenue/Publix – Northbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews mill the temporary asphalt and install conduit on the bay side.

Crews will place base rock and construct intersections at the following driveways and side streets:

Access from Estero Boulevard to the above side streets will be closed. Motorists should use Shell Mound Boulevard to detour to Voorhis Street or Jefferson Street to access Estero Boulevard. This work and the suggested detours are expected to take approximately 2 weeks.

- **South of Donora Boulevard to Jefferson Street** – Crews will form and pour bay side sidewalk.
- **Anchorage Street to Strandview Avenue/Publix** – Crews will install drainage structures and pipe at each side street working from north to south over the next couple months.

Segment 3 and 4 – Strandview Avenue/Publix to Albatross Street

reFRESH Estero Boulevard crews are installing the new sanitary sewer force main on the bay side of Estero Boulevard.

Strandview Avenue/Publix to Flamingo Street – Northbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews install sanitary sewer force main on the bay side.

Segment 5 and 6 – Albatross Street to end of island

No work at this time.

Phase 2 – Lovers Lane to Madera Road

reFRESH Waterlines crews are installing water main on the beach side of Estero Boulevard and installing connections to bay side streets.

Side streets from Mid Island to Gulfview Avenue – Crews are connecting the following side streets to the new water main.

- **Andre Mar Drive, Anchorage Street, St. Peters Drive, Hibiscus Drive and Coconut Drive** – Monday 3/19 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. This connection requires residents to boil water. Water shut-off/boil water notices were hand-delivered Friday, March 16, 2018.

Phase 2 – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing new water main and storm drainage on the following side streets:

Eucalyptus Court	Connecticut Street
Jefferson Street	Bay Mar Drive
Donora Boulevard	Hercules Drive
Bay Road	Bayview Avenue

Donora Boulevard – Crews are making individual water connections.

Eucalyptus Court – Crews are restoring the right-of-way.

Jefferson Street – Crews are restoring the right-of-way.

Connecticut Street – Crews are scheduled to install storm drain.

Bay Mar Drive – Crews have installed water main and are preparing for pressure testing.

Hercules Drive – Crews will install storm drain pipe.

Bayview Avenue – Crews are scheduled to work on the bay seawall.
