Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Lovers Lane to Albatross Street. Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.



# **Estero Boulevard Improvements**

This week, reFRESH Estero Boulevard crews are scheduled to perform the following activities on Estero Boulevard. The active work zone is from Lovers Lane to Albatross Street. Motorists should expect travel lanes on Estero Boulevard to be shifted from Lovers Lane south to Albatross Street. Two travel lanes will remain open the majority of the time; however, intermittent lane closures may be necessary. Motorists should use caution.

# <u>Segment 2 – Lovers Lane to Strandview Avenue/Publix</u>

### **Lovers Lane to Strandview Avenue**

Motorists can expect intermittent lane and sidewalk closures for repairs.

# Segment 3 & 4 - Strandview Avenue/Publix to Albatross Street

<u>Strandview Avenue to south of Madera Road</u> – Southbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews reconstruct the roadway, install concrete sidewalk and curb on the beachside.

<u>South of Madera Road to Sterling Avenue</u> – The center lane remains closed while crews install the center lane drainage system.

Barrier wall or barrels will separate the northbound and southbound lanes. Motorists should expect to make U-turns when accessing properties on the opposite side of the road from the travel lane. Motorists exiting side streets and driveways between south of Madera Road and north of Lazy Way must make right turns onto Estero Boulevard and then make a U-turn.

### **Side Street Outfalls:**

**Ibis Street** – Crews will continue restoration.



# **Waterlines Construction**

## Phase 3 – Estero Boulevard from Madera Road to Albatross Street

reFRESH Waterlines crews are installing water main on both sides of Estero Boulevard and installing connections to side streets.

<u>Lazy Way to Gulf Drive</u> – North and south bound traffic is shifted to the beachside for water main installation on the bayside.

<u>Gulf Drive to Albatross Street</u> – North and south bound traffic is shifted to the bayside for water main installation on the beachside.

# Phase 3 – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are completing restoration work on the following side streets:

Madera Road
Williams Drive/Glenview Manor Drive
Dakota Avenue
Palmetto Street
Lazy Way
Aberdeen Avenue
Lauder Street
Dundee Road
Mound Road
Driftwood Lane

<u>Driftwood Lane</u> – Remaining road and right-of-way restoration will be completed after Lee County installs the storm drain outfall.

# Phase 4 – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach installing storm drainage on the following side streets:

Redfish Road Lagoon Road
Tarpon Road Buccaneer Drive

Lenell Road (to follow Laguna Shores work)

### Lagoon Road

Crews will continue to install storm drain pipe from Tarpon Road north.

#### **Redfish Road**

• Crews will continue to install storm drain pipe from Estero Boulevard to Lagoon Road.

### **Tarpon Road**

- Scheduled to be closed from Estero Boulevard to Lagoon Road from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Local traffic will be accommodated. Through traffic to follow detour signs.
- Crews are scheduled to relocate water main where it conflicts with the storm drain installation.
