Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Lovers Lane to the south end of the island.

Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may also experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. *This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.*

**Construction in Progress**  
Segment 2 (Lovers Ln to Strandview Ave/Publix) and Segment 3 & 4 (Strandview Ave/Publix to Albatross Street)

#### UPDATES BY AREA

##### Segment 2 - Lovers Lane to Strandview Avenue/Publix

Motorists can expect intermittent lane and sidewalk closures for repairs.

##### Segment 3 & 4 - Strandview Ave/Publix to Albatross Street

**Bayland Road to Lazy Way** – Northbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews reconstruct the roadway, install concrete curb, driveways, and sidewalk on the bayside.

**Lazy Way to Albatross Street** - Crews will be clearing the remainder of the Estero Boulevard road right-of-way (ROW) to prepare for upcoming Estero Boulevard Improvements.

**Lazy Way to Gulf Drive** – North and south bound traffic is shifted to the beachside.

**Gulf Drive to Albatross Street** - North and south bound traffic is shifted to the bayside.

**Construction in Progress**  
Phase 4 (Estero Blvd from Albatross Street to the south end of the island), Phase 3 Side Streets and Phase 4 Side Streets.

#### UPDATES BY AREA

##### Phase 4 – Estero Boulevard from Albatross Street to the south end of the Island

**Albatross Street to the south end of the island** Crews are continuing to install water main in the closed beachside lane at the following locations:

- Bay Beach Lane and work south

**Lenell Road reduced to one lane at Estero Boulevard** - Monday, February 24 and potentially Tuesday, February 25, while crews install water main across Lenell Road east of the fire station.

**Flaggers will be present to assist motorists entering or exiting Lenell Road. Motorists should expect delays.**

##### Phase 3 – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are completing restoration work on the following side streets:

- Madera Road
- Aberdeen Avenue
- Williams Drive/Glenview Manor Drive
- Lauder Street
- Dakota Avenue
- Dundee Road
- Palmetto Street
- Mound Road
- Lazy Way

**Driftwood Lane** – Remaining road and right-of-way restoration will be completed after Lee County installs the storm drain

outfall.

#### Phase 4 – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing storm drainage on the following side streets:

- Redfish Road
- Lagoon Road
- Tarpon Road
- Buccaneer Drive
- Lenell Road

Crews are restoring right-of-way.
