

Construction Look Ahead

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Strandview Avenue/Publix to the south end of the island.

Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may also experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.

UPDATES BY AREA

<u>Segment 3 & 4 - Strandview Ave/Publix to</u> <u>Albatross Street</u>

Bayland Road to Avenida Pescadora - The center lane is <u>currently</u> closed. Monday, March 23, motorists should expect the southbound traffic to shift to the center lane while crews work on the beachside.

Avenida Pescadora to Sterling Avenue - The northbound lane is <u>currently</u> shifted to the center lane. Monday, March 23, motorists should expect the northbound and southbound traffic to shift to the bayside while crews work on the beachside.

Sterling Avenue to Gulf Drive – North and south bound traffic is shifted to the beachside while crews work on the bayside.

Gulf Drive to Albatross Street - North and south bound traffic is shifted to the bayside.

Phase 4 (Estero Blvd from Albatross Street to the south end of the island), Phase 3 Side Streets and Phase 4 Side Streets.

Phase 4 – Estero Boulevard from Albatross Street to the south end of the Island

Albatross Street to the south end of the island North and south bound traffic is shifted to the bayside while crews continue to install water main in the closed beachside lane at the following locations:

Bay Beach Lane and work south

Lenell Road - Tuesday, March 24, crews are scheduled to make a force main connection in the north lane of Lenell Road. This work will cause temporary closure of the following:

- Lenell Road north sidewalk between Estero Boulevard and CVS Lenell Road driveway.
- Lenell Road north right hand turn lane.
- Lenell Road Santini Marina Plaza driveway closest to Estero Boulevard.

Flaggers will be present to assist motorists exiting Lenell Road. Motorists should expect delays.

Phase 3 – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are completing restoration work on the following side streets:

- Madera Road
- Aberdeen Avenue
- Williams Drive/Glenview Manor Drive

- Lauder Street
- Dakota Avenue
- Dundee Road
- Palmetto Street
- Mound Road
- Lazy Way

Driftwood Lane — Remaining road and right-of-way restoration will be completed after Lee County installs the storm drain outfall.

Phase 4 – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing storm drainage on the following side streets:

- Redfish Road
- Lagoon Road
- Tarpon Road
- Buccaneer Drive
- Lenell Road
