Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Strandview Avenue/Publix to the south end of the island.

Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may also experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. *This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.*

Construction in Progress Segment 3 & 4 (Strandview Ave/Publix to Albatross Street)

UPDATES BY AREA

Segment 3 & 4 - Strandview Ave/Publix to Albatross Street

Bayland Road to Dakota Avenue -Southbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews install conduit and rebuild the roadway on the beachside.

Dakota Avenue to Lazy Way - Northbound traffic is <u>currently</u> shifted to the center lane while crews restore concrete driveways on the bayside.

• Motorists should expect traffic to shift late this week. North and south bound traffic will shift to the bayside for beachside work.

Lazy Way to Lanark Avenue - The center lane is closed for storm drain installation.

• Lazy Way to Aberdeen Avenue -Barrels separate the northbound and southbound lanes. Motorists should expect to make U-turns when accessing properties on the opposite side of the road from the travel lane. Motorists exiting side streets and driveways from Lazy Way to Aberdeen Avenue must make right turns onto Estero Boulevard and then make a U-turn.

Lanark Avenue to Gulf Drive – North bound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews work on the bayside.

Gulf Drive to Albatross Street - North and south bound traffic is shifted to the bayside.

• Bahia Via to Ibis Street - Thursday, April 9, crews are scheduled to pave the closed beachside lane.

Construction in Progress Phase 4 (Estero Blvd from Albatross Street to the south end of the island), Phase 3 Side Streets and Phase 4 Side Streets.

<u>Phase 4 – Estero Boulevard from</u> <u>Albatross Street to the south end of the</u> <u>Island</u>

Albatross Street to the south end of the island North and south bound traffic is shifted to the bayside while crews continue to install water main in the closed beachside lane.

• Motorists should expect intermittent one-lane traffic from at Lenell Road and from Buccaneer Drive to the south end of the island. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays.

Bay Beach Lane - Beginning 7 a.m. on Monday, April 6, the south side lanes of Bay Beach Lane at Estero Boulevard will be reduced to one lane while crews install pipe fittings and bury the water main pipe on the south side of Bay Beach Lane.

Flaggers will be present to assist motorists entering or exiting Bay Beach Lane. Motorists should expect delays. <u>Phase 3 – Side Streets</u>
