



## EMERGENCY BOIL WATER NOTICE

Beginning immediately  
Tuesday, May 12, 2020

This **EMERGENCY boil water notice** is addressed to and affects the following:

**7146, 7148 & 7150 Estero Boulevard - Creciente Condominium**

A boil water notice is effective immediately on Tuesday, May 12, as part of the Town of Fort Myers Beach Waterlines Project. **Once your water service is back on, you are required to boil your water until a boil water rescission notice is issued (typically 3-5 days).** Water service is expected to be restored by 4 p.m.

**THEREFORE, AS A PRECAUTION, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR DRINKING, COOKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, OR WASHING DISHES BE BOILED. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used. THIS "EMERGENCY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE WORK IS COMPLETED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK AT WHICH TIME WE WILL ISSUE A RESCISSION NOTICE.**
