

Construction Look Ahead

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Strandview Avenue/Publix to the south end of the island.

Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may also experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.

Crews will not work Friday, July 3 and Saturday, July 4 for the 4th of July Holiday.

<u>Segment 3 & 4 (Strandview Ave/Publix to Albatross Street)</u>

UPDATES BY AREA

<u>Segment 3 & 4 - Strandview Ave/Publix to Albatross Street</u>

Publix to Lazy Way - The center lane is closed for paver brick work.

Lazy Way to north of Aberdeen Avenue -Southbound traffic is shifted to the center lane while crews remove temporary asphalt, install conduit and curb and rebuild the roadway on the beach side.

North of Aberdeen Avenue to Flamingo Street - The center lane is closed for storm drain installation.

 Barrels separate the northbound and southbound lanes. Motorists should expect to make U-turns when accessing properties on the opposite side of the road from the travel lane. Motorists exiting side streets and driveways from north of Aberdeen Avenue to Flamingo Street must make right turns onto Estero Boulevard and then make a U-turn.

Flamingo Street to Albatross Street – North and southbound traffic is shifted to the beach side while crews install storm drainage, conduit, and rebuild the roadway on the bay side.

 On Tuesday, June 30, Estero Boulevard driveways between Flamingo Street and Ibis Street may be closed while crews install curb.

Construction in Progress

<u>Phase 4 (Estero Blvd</u> from Albatross Street to the south end of the island), <u>Phase 3 Side Streets</u> and <u>Phase 4 Side</u> Streets.

UPDATES BY AREA

<u>Phase 4 – Estero Boulevard from Albatross Street to the south end of the Island</u>

Albatross Street to the south end of the island - North and south bound traffic is shifted bay side.

 Crews will continue to install temporary pavement on the beach side from the general area of Lenell Road south to Buccaneer Drive.

Buccanner Drive to Estrellita Drive

- Crews are installing 4" water main pipe on the bay side of Estero Boulevard.
- Crews have closed the bay side sidewalk. Pedestrians are directed to the temporary pavement installed on the beach side.
- Tarpon Road temporary closure -On Tuesday, June 30, Tarpon Road will be closed at Estero Boulevard while crews install water main. Motorists should use Redfish Road or Buccaneer Drive for entering and exiting Laguna Shores during this work.

Phase 3 – Side Streets

Driftwood Lane – Remaining road and right-of-way restoration will be completed after Lee County installs the storm drain outfall.

Phase 4 – Side Streets

Beach are installing storm drainage on the following side streets:

- Redfish Road
- Lagoon Road
- Tarpon Road
- Buccaneer Drive
- Lenell Road

Lagoon Road, Redfish Road, & Tarpon Road - Crews are working on punch list items to finalize road right-of-way restoration.

Lenell Road

- Crews will continue to intermittently flush the new water main pipe.
- Crews are expected to begin the storm drain improvements after the water main connections have been completed.
