**WATER SHUT-OFF AND PRECAUTIONARY
BOIL WATER NOTICE Due to Water Shut-Off**

This **precautionary boil water notice and WATER SHUT-OFF** is addressed to and affects the following:

- **All addresses on Island Pines Way including the following:**
 - **Captains Bay North II - 6691 Estero Blvd**
 - **Captain's Bay South – 22700, 22712, 22724, 22736, 22748 Island Pines Way**
 - **Bac Bay Health and Racquet – 22676 Island Pines Way**
 - **Admiral's Bay – 22652 Island Pines Way**
 - **Estero Bayside – 22604, 22628 Island Pines Way**
 - **Island Pines Recreational – 22664 Island Pines Way**

A WATER SHUT-OFF due to the connection to the water main is required and is scheduled as part of the Town of Fort Myers Beach Waterlines Project on Estero Boulevard.

You are required to boil your water until a boil water rescission notice is issued (typically 3-5 days).

THEREFORE, AS A PRECAUTION, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR DRINKING, COOKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, OR WASHING DISHES BE BOILED. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE WORK IS COMPLETED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK AT WHICH TIME WE WILL ISSUE A RESCISSION NOTICE. The local fire department and EMS have been notified of this shut off and will closely monitor affected properties and fire suppression systems. You are responsible to notify your fire protection company, if applicable.
