Your water will be shut off beginning at 8 a.m. through 11 a.m.

WATER SHUT-OFF AND PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE due to water shut-off

This **precautionary boil water notice and WATER SHUT-OFF** is addressed to and affects the following:

- **Primo Drive from Estero Boulevard to the bay (both sides)**
- **Silver Sands Resort - 1207 Estero Boulevard**
- **The Doghouse Restaurant – 1207 Estero Boulevard**
- **The Beached Whale Restaurant – 1249 Estero Boulevard**

A **WATER SHUT-OFF** for the connection to the new water main is required and is scheduled as part of the Town of Fort Myers Beach Waterlines Project.

Beginning Monday, 11/30/20 at 8 a.m., you are required to boil your water until a boil water rescission notice is issued (typically 3-5 days).

THEREFORE, AS A PRECAUTION, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR DRINKING, COOKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, OR WASHING DISHES BE BOILED. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

THIS “PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE” WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE WORK IS COMPLETED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK AT WHICH TIME WE WILL ISSUE A RESCISSION NOTICE. The local fire department and EMS have been notified of this shut off and will closely monitor affected properties and fire suppression systems. **You are responsible to notify your fire protection company, if applicable.**

After the water shut-off, beginning Monday, November 30 through Friday, December 11, crews will connect individual water services to the new water main. Your water will be shut off one time (typically no longer than 30 minutes but may be up to 2 hours) while crews make the connection to your water meter. The shut off will occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Crews will make every effort to contact you just prior to shutting off your water.

Fire line connections will be individually scheduled.
