



reFRESH Waterlines Project
Individual services to be connected to the new water main
February 5 through February 11, 2019



Beginning Tuesday, February 5 through Monday, February 11, crews will connect individual water services to the new water main. Crews will connect services to:

- **5025 Compass Lane**
- **201 Randy Lane**
- **5110, 5120, 5130, 5031 and 5037 Williams Drive**

Your water will be shut off one time (typically no longer than 30 minutes but may be up to 2 hours) during the next two weeks while crews make the connection to your water meter. The shut-off will occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Crews will make every effort to contact you just prior to shutting off your water. **You will NOT need to boil your water when the water connection is complete.**

The reFRESH Waterlines team is replacing the water system throughout the Town of Fort Myers Beach to improve services to businesses and residents on the island. Just as the Town is replacing old pipes within the right-of-way, property owners may also need to update their private systems leading to and contained within their homes and buildings.

This notice is to inform you that the Town's reFRESH Waterlines team will soon be connecting your residence to the new water main as part of the Town of Fort Myers Beach Waterline Replacement Program. Due to the age of many homes and the aging plumbing systems within them, you may experience plumbing issues and should be prepared to contact a licensed plumber for repairs.
