Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Strandview Avenue/Publix to the south end of the island.

Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may also experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. *This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.*

### Construction in Progress

<u>Segments 3 & 4 (Strandview Ave/Publix</u> to Albatross Street) and Segments 5 & 6 (Albatross Street to the end of the island)

# UPDATES BY AREA

Segment 3 & 4 - Strandview Ave/Publix to Albatross Street

• Motorists may experience intermittent lane closures while crews work on the center lane drainage system and restore the road right-of-way.

Segment 5 & 6 - Albatross Street to the end of the island

Albatross Street to the south end of the island.

- North and south bound traffic is <u>currently</u> shifted to the beach side while crews clear the right-of-way, install storm drainage and sidewalk and rebuild the roadway on the bay side.
- Lenell Road to south of Santini Plaza - <u>The week of May 10</u>, crews are expected to pave the closed bay side lane.
- Albatross Street to south of Santini Plaza - <u>The week of May 10</u>, once the bay side lane is paved, crews will shift both lanes of traffic to the bay side so they can begin work on the beach side.

Phase 4 – Estero Boulevard from Albatross Street to the south end of the Island

### **Bayview Boulevard**

- Crews will continue testing the new water line and preparing for individual connections.
- Crews are expected to mill portions of the asphalt and final pave.

### North Estero – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing new waterlines and storm drain improvements on the following side streets:

- Primo Drive
- Palermo Circle
- Santos Road
- Carlos Circle
- Lagoon Street
- Matanzas Street and Matanzas Court

Crews are restoring the road right-of-way on all streets listed above.

## "Downtown" Waterline and Storm Drainage

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing new waterlines and storm drain improvements on the following downtown streets:

- front of Santini Plaza has been removed for Estero Boulevard improvement work.
- Tarpon Road Tuesday, 4/4, Tarpon Road at Estero Boulevard will be closed while crews adjust a sewer manhole. Residential access will be provided from Buccaneer Drive and Lagoon Road.

Crews will continue to restore the outfalls right-of-way in the following locations:

- Santa Maria Condominiums
- Estero Bay Improvement Association (EBIA)

- Third Street
- Bonita Street
- Harbor Court
- First Street
- Second Street
- Fifth Street
- Crescent Street

Third Street (west of Old San Carlos Boulevard), Bonita Street and Harbor Court

- Crews are expected to continue the installation of the dewatering system.
- Monday, 5/3 crews will begin watermain installation on Harbor Court.
