Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Strandview Avenue/Publix to the south end of the island.

Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may also experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. *This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.*

**Construction in Progress**

Segments 3 & 4 (Strandview Ave/Publix to Albatross Street) and Segments 5 & 6 (Albatross Street to the end of the island)

**UPDATES BY AREA****Segment 3 & 4 - Strandview Ave/Publix to Albatross Street**

- Motorists may experience intermittent lane closures for punch list items.

**Segment 5 & 6 - Albatross Street to the end of the island**

**Albatross Street to just south of Santini Plaza** - North and south bound traffic is shifted to the bay side while crews install conduit, storm drainage and sidewalk and rebuild the roadway on the beach side.

**South of Santini Plaza to the south end of the island** - North and south bound traffic is shifted to the beach side while crews install storm drainage and sidewalk and rebuild the roadway on the bay side.

- **Buccaneer Drive**
  - Buccaneer Drive will be intermittently reduced to one lane at Estero Boulevard while crews install storm drainage.
  - Motorists should use caution and flaggers will be present to assist.
- **Redfish Road**
  - Redfish Road will be closed intermittently from Estero Boulevard to Buccaneer Drive while crews transition the side street apron to Estero Boulevard.
  - Residential access will be provided from Buccaneer Drive and Lagoon Road.

**Construction in Progress**

Phase 4 (Estero Blvd from Albatross Street to the south end of the island) and North Estero Side Streets.

**UPDATES BY AREA****Phase 4 – Estero Boulevard from Albatross Street to the south end of the Island****Bayview Boulevard**

- Crews will install sod and restore the road right-of-way.

**North Estero – Side Streets**

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing new water lines and storm drain improvements on the following side streets:

- Primo Drive
- Palermo Circle
- Santos Road
- Carlos Circle
- Lagoon Street
- Matanzas Street and Matanzas Court

Crews are restoring the road right-of-way on all streets listed above.

**"Downtown" Water line and Storm Drainage**

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing new water lines and storm drain improvements on the following downtown streets:

- Third Street
- Bonita Street
- Harbor Court
- First Street
- Second Street
- Fifth Street
- Crescent Street

**Third Street (west of Old San Carlos Boulevard), Bonita Street and Harbor**

- Tarpon Road
  - Tarpon Road will be closed intermittently from Estero Boulevard to Buccaneer Drive while crews transition the side street apron to Estero Boulevard.
  - Residential access will be provided from Buccaneer Drive and Lagoon Road.

Crews will continue to restore the outfalls right-of-way in the following locations:

- Santa Maria Condominiums
- Estero Bay Improvement Association (EBIA)

Court

- Crews are expected to continue water line installation on Third Street working toward Old San Carlos Boulevard.

Crescent Street, First Street, Second Street, Fifth Street, and Third Street (east of Old San Carlos Boulevard)

- Crews are expected to continue the installation of the dewatering system.

Crescent Street

- Crews are expected to continue water line installation on Crescent Street.
- Crescent Street will be intermittently reduced to one lane of traffic during the water line installation.
- Residential and business traffic will be accommodated.
- Motorists should follow detour signs and flaggers will be present to assist.

Second Street

- Crews will continue water line installation. No further road closures are expected at this time.

Third Street (east of Old San Carlos Boulevard)

- Crews are expected to temporarily close Third Street between Old San Carlos Boulevard and Crescent Street while they continue water line installation.
- Residential and business traffic will be accommodated.
- Motorists should follow detour signs to First Street and flaggers will be present to assist.

Fifth Street

- Beginning Wednesday, 6/23, crews are expected to reduce Fifth Street to one lane traffic for water line installation.
- Business traffic will be accommodated.
- Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays.
