



WATER SHUT-OFF AND PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE CANCELLED AND RESCHEDULED

for Tuesday, July 13, 2021

Beginning at 9 a.m. through 1 p.m.

The Tuesday, July 6 water shut-off has been cancelled due to Tropical Storm Elsa and rescheduled for Tuesday, July 13. This **precautionary boil water notice and WATER SHUT-OFF** is addressed to and affects the following:

- **7307, 7317, and 7327 Estero Boulevard – Santa Maria Condominiums**
 - **Domestic Service**
 - **Fire Service**

A **WATER SHUT-OFF** for the connection to the water main is required and is scheduled as part of the Town of Fort Myers Beach Waterlines Project on Estero Boulevard.

You are required to boil your water until a boil water rescission notice is issued (typically 3-5 days).

THEREFORE, AS A PRECAUTION, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR DRINKING, COOKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, OR WASHING DISHES BE BOILED. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

THIS “PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE” WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE WORK IS COMPLETED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK AT WHICH TIME WE WILL ISSUE A RESCISSION NOTICE. The local fire department and EMS have been notified of this shut off and will closely monitor affected properties and fire suppression systems. **You are responsible to notify your fire protection company, if applicable.**
