Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Albatross Street to the south end of the island.

Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may also experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. *This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.*

Segments 5 & 6 (Albatross Street to the end of the island)

Segment 5 & 6 - Albatross Street to the end of the island

Albatross Street to the south end of the island

- North and south bound traffic is shifted to the bay side while crews install conduit, storm drainage and sidewalk and rebuild the roadway on the beach side.
- Periodically, crews will be working on the bay side to complete right-of-way restoration and construction punch list items.

Crews will continue to restore the outfall right-of-way at the Santa Maria Condominium.

Construction in Progress North Estero Side Streets

UPDATES BY AREA

North Estero – Side Streets

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing new water lines and storm drain improvements on the following side streets:

- Primo Drive
- Palermo Circle
- Santos Road
- Carlos Circle
- Lagoon Street
- Matanzas Street and Matanzas Court

Matanzas Street - Crews will be installing the dewatering system for upcoming additional storm drainage outfall work.

"Downtown" Water line and Storm Drainage

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing new water lines and storm drain improvements on the following downtown streets:

- Third Street
- Bonita Street
- Harbor Court
- First Street
- Second Street
- Fifth Street
- Crescent Street

Third Street (west of Old San Carlos Boulevard), Bonita Street and Harbor Court

- Crews are completing punch list items and preparing for final paving.

Third Street (east of Old San Carlos Boulevard), First Street, Second Street, Fifth Street, and Crescent Street

Third Street

- Beginning Monday, 11/29, Third Street from Old San Carlos Boulevard to Crescent Street will be closed while crews rebuild the roadway, install concrete curb, sidewalk and driveway aprons.
- This closure will remain in place for approximately three weeks.

Crescent Street

- Crescent Street from Fifth Street to Third Street will be reduced to one lane while crews rebuild the roadway, install concrete curb, sidewalk and driveway aprons.
- Crescent Street from Estero Boulevard to Fifth Street will be intermittently reduced to one lane while crews install storm drainage and concrete curb, sidewalk, and driveway aprons.
 - Once the Estero Boulevard to Fifth Street referenced work is complete, this area will close again for final paving.

For all road closures listed above:

1. Through motorists should follow detour signs.
2. Residential traffic will be accommodated.
