Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, and sidewalk and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Albatross Street to the south end of the island.

Two travel lanes are expected to remain open the majority of the project; however, motorists may experience daytime or nighttime one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may also experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Construction will be year-round. This schedule may change due to underground conditions and inclement weather.

Estero Boulevard Segments 5 & 6 (Albatross Street to the end of the island)

<u>Segment 5 & 6 - Albatross Street to the end of the island</u>

Albatross Street to the south end of the island

- North and south bound traffic is shifted to the bay side while crews install storm drainage, and concrete sidewalk and driveway aprons on the beach side.
- Monday, 1/17, crews are expected to remove and replace specific bay side areas of concrete curb, sidewalk and driveways. Temporary sidewalk closures will be necessary for these punch list items to be completed.
- Motorists may experience intermittent one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard while crews clean the storm drain and make concrete repairs. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays.

Crews will continue to restore the outfall right-of-way at the Santa Maria Condominium.

"Downtown" Water line and Storm Drainage

Contractors for the Town of Fort Myers Beach are installing new water lines and storm drain improvements on the following downtown streets:

- Third Street
- Bonita Street
- Harbor Court
- First Street
- Second Street
- Fifth Street
- Crescent Street

Third Street (west of Old San Carlos Boulevard), Bonita Street and Harbor Court

• Crews are working on punch list items.

Third Street (east of Old San Carlos Boulevard), First Street, Second Street, Fifth Street, and Crescent Street

Second Street

 Second Street will continue to be closed from Old San Carlos Boulevard to Crescent Street while crews rebuild the road and install concrete sidewalks, curb, and driveway aprons.

Third Street

 Third Street is expected to remain open while crews install concrete sidewalks, curb, and driveway aprons.

Crescent Street

- During normal work hours, Crescent Street will be reduced to one lane from Second Street to Third Street while crews continue installation of concrete sidewalks, curb and driveway aprons. The week of 1/17, crews are expected to begin rebuilding this section of Crescent Street one lane at a time.
- Flaggers will be present to assist motorists during construction.
